After removing the protection paper press firmly over the entire bag surface. The bags should be fixed at temperatures of > +10 ° C.

8. Durability and Stocking

When kept in a dark and dry place at room temperature (between $+10^{\circ}$ C and $+30^{\circ}$ C), the pouches can last for 2 years.

9. Disposal
